#### This funding will be used to

- Support 85%+ students in attaining a C/Working With or higher in English
- Enable 100% of students articulating their individual goals in English

#### Our initiatives include

- Initiating conversations in regards to English A-E results through the use of a case management approach (data wall and individual referral process)
- Providing time for teachers to regularly discuss their classes' data and own performance with the Principal/Head Of Department -Curriculum (HOD-C) to ensure the right work is happening every day, in all classrooms
- Increasing teacher knowledge of curriculum and their learners to strengthen abitility to cater for diverse learners
- Maximising support for targeted 'marker students' for individuals/groups/whole class according to collaboratively designed English data walls
- Involving teachers in the review of the school Curriculum, Assessment & Reporting Plan and using this to inform whole year/term/class/individual planning for English
- Supporting teachers with the workload of planning, implementing, assessing and moderating of English by giving time to complete planning/training/collaboration tasks
- Strengthening the presentation of all classrooms, and in particular learning walls for English, by giving time to teachers on a regular basis to do this work
- Increasing the flexibility of classroom set-ups by providing more wall space for teachers as well
  as the ability to move large technology items around their classrooms
